Dr. Charlie Garnjana-Goonchorn joined the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in 2007. He started his career working at the Treaty Division overseeing various aspects of Thailand's treaty making process. Upon returning to Thailand in 2017, he played a key role in several international disputes involving the Royal Thai Government, in addition to providing legal advice related to international trade, investment treaties, dispute settlement mechanisms and arbitration. Dr. Garnjana-Goonchorn served at the Royal Thai Consulate-General, Sydney, in the capacity of Deputy Consul-General. He is now the Director of Legal Affairs Division, and oversees various legal issues such as the Law of the Sea, Privilege and Immunity, Environmental Law, and the Law on Cyber Security.
